

REQUIRED PAPERWORK

BLOODWORK:

- Fill out a Registration Form for each dog
- Due to the large amount of blood required for the OFA Thyroid panel, dogs under 25 lbs. cannot get this test in conjunction with any other blood test.

OFA DATABASE(S) APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS:

- Download and complete your **OFA Thyroid** and **Cardiac** application(s) here:

- Bring the completed form to your appointment on the day of the clinic, so that the veterinarian can complete his section.
- A check for \$7.50 payable to the OFA and the completed OFA form must accompany the specimen.
- The OFA will send a certificate directly to the owner in four (4) to six (6) weeks.
- OFA applications will also be available at the clinic.

AKC CERTIFICATION AND OFA REGISTRATION

AKC DNA certification and OFA registry applications.

- Full registered name of dog
- Registration information
- Full name of owner(s)
- Dog's permanent identification number

RABIES AND LICENSES

- Bring your dogs' current/previous rabies certificate to receive a 3-year vaccine.
- Without proof of previous vaccine, as required by law, you will receive a 1-year vaccine.

MICROCHIP (24petwatch)

- Bring your vet's name and contact information
- Bring a secondary contact person's name and phone number.

SERVICES

CARDIAC EXAMS

with Michael S. Miller, MS, VMD, DABVP Practice Limited to Cardiology

The cardiac exam includes an echocardiogram, ultrasound, ECG, auscultation, and a brief report for your veterinarian. The cardiac exam screens for congenital heart defects, Cardiomyopathy, valvular disease, and arrhythmias.

OFA EYE CERTIFICATION REGISTRY (ECR) EXAM

with Jeffrey E. Bowersox, DVM, DACVO Ophthalmologist

The OFA ECR exam is a general eye exam, which screens for genetic and non-genetic abnormalities in dogs that are being considered for a breeding program. The OFA ECR exam is not a medical examination for existing problems.

- ECR applications are NOT available online.
- ECR applications WILL be available at the clinic.
- Initial submissions of passing results are \$12.
- Resubmissions of passing results are \$8.
- Submissions to open database of non-passing results are free.
- All fees are paid directly to the OFA.

AKC DNA CERTIFICATION

The DNA Profile Program is for owners and breeders electing to add value to their breeding programs by eliminating concerns or questions about identification and parentage. AKC DNA Profiling is required for:

- Frequently used sires (dogs having the greatest impact on the AKC Stud Book)
- Imported breeding stock.
- Dogs whose semen is collected for fresh extended or frozen use.
- The sires, dam and puppies for Multiple-Sired Litter Registration.
- We will collect the DNA sample from the dog and return it to AKC.
- You will receive a certificate directly from AKC in about six weeks

AKC CANINE GOOD CITIZEN TESTS

An AKC certified CGC/CGCA evaluator will be on hand to administer CGC and CGCA tests. The tests are open to all purebred and mixed breed dogs. CGC/CGCA are certificate/title programs that is designed to reward dogs who have good manners at home and in the community, and provides an excellent foundation for other training. CGCA dogs must have earned their CGC and be registered with the AKC (http://www.akc.org/dogowner/training/akc_community_canine/about.cfm).

REGISTRATION:

- Registration form return deadline is: **FEBRUARY 14, 2017.**
- NO appointments will be scheduled after the deadline - No exceptions.
- You must complete a **separate** registration form for each dog.
- You must complete a separate DNA disease testing submission form for each dog.

- Please arrive at the clinic at least 15 minutes before your first scheduled appointment.
