All entries must indicate class "A" or "B" and a jump height where in classes that require jumps. Entries that do not include "A" or "B" and appropriate jump height will be entered in the "B" classes

**RAE entries:** Dogs entered in this RAE class will be entered in both Advanced B and Excellent B, and the combined entry fee for these two classes must be paid. If due to entry limits an exhibitor cannot be entered in both the Advanced B and Excellent B classes, the entry will be placed on the wait list.

**RACH entries:** Dogs entered in the RACH class will be entered in Advanced B, Excellent B and the Master class. The combined entry fee for these three classes must be paid. If due to entry limits an exhibitor cannot be entered in the Advanced B, Excellent B and Master classes, the entry will be placed on the wait list.

**WAIT LIST:** A wait list will be kept to fill entries that are withdrawn prior to the closing date and time. Once the trial is closed and the limits have been reached, all entries on the wait list not accepted into the trial will be returned. There is no post-closing wait list.

**TRANSFERS:** Transfers will be allowed. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

**Step 3: Include the AKC number of the dog being paid for so that we can match payment to entry forms.**

If you use an entry service (superintendent, online entry or fax service) other than the Show Secretary listed in the premium, please be aware of their terms additional charges and delivery policies. Entries are processed in the order that they are received at the address of the Show Secretary.

Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the back of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries received without fees, postdated checks, returned checks or declined credit cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. **Refunds of \$8 or less will not be issued due to the cost of processing.**

PLEASE make your entries correct and legible. Illegible entries cannot be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Owners/Agents are responsible for errors on entry forms. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6). Each Owner/Agent listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at the show is bound by the Certification and Agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed and submitted the form. No entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors, or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. No refund for duplicate entries. No entry will be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 first entry only and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 will be required for each first entry, \$3.00 for each additional entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2)

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made.

No entry may be changed or canceled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Show Secretary prior to the closing date and hour for entries. Owners are responsible for errors in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

# Notice to Exhibitors

## **REFUND POLICY:**

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in obedience trials. The club will refund all but a \$10 administrative fee of the entry fee for bitches in season that are unable to compete for that reason. Refund requests must be accompanied by a dated, signed letter on official business letterhead or official email from your veterinarian stating the reason that your dog cannot compete. The Trial Secretary must be notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial. Phone calls and non-letterhead notes will not be considered.

- The Rally ring is 32x65 feet.
- Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for clean conditions in and around their crating area. No wire crates or x-pens on the matted floors. Crating space will be limited.
- There is no space for un-entered dogs. Dogs may not be left overnight.
- All trophies must be claimed on the day of the show. None will be mailed. Unclaimed awards become the property of Wilmington Kennel Club
- The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called. All dogs present must be held on a leash, or confined to a crate except when being judged.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations
- **It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The host club, Clantyre Show Secretary Services and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, illness, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.**
- Wilmington Kennel Club DOES NOT agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for these events.

## COVID-19 SOCIAL DISTANCING PLAN—WILMINGTON KENNEL CLUB (WKC)

### AKC RALLY TRIALS – March 13 & 14, 2021

As of the publication of this Premium, WKC is following the State of Delaware's Plan with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic. Adjustments to this Plan will be made as needed should the State of Delaware and/or the AKC require any changes. Any updates to this Plan will be sent to the exhibitors along with the Judging Program. Everyone who attends these trials is covered by this Plan as outlined below.

**Any person who fails to follow this Plan and who fails to maintain at least six feet between individuals at all times during this event or on the show grounds during show hours may result in expulsion from this event.**

**WHEN TO STAY HOME** – You should NOT attend the Trial(s) if you cannot answer YES to the following: “To the best of my knowledge, I am not infected with the virus known to cause the disease currently referred to as COVID-19. I also state that I am free of symptoms of such infection including but not limited to: FEVER, COUGH, SHORTNESS OF BREATH, AND/OR PERSISTENT PAIN/PRESSURE IN THE CHEST. I have also not to my knowledge been in direct contact with anyone diagnosed with the virus known to cause the disease currently referred to COVID-19 in the last 14 days.” Please text the Event Secretary if you are unable to attend because of answering NO to the above statements. (Arlene Hitchens, 302-547-1257). At this point, you will be refunded 50% of your entry fee(s). Anyone who attends a public gathering must recognize they will always be at risk to contract COVID-19 despite all the precautions that will be taken to reduce the risk.

**FACE MASKS** – Face masks will be required of everyone AT ALL TIMES while in the building, including while exhibiting. Your mask must cover your nose, mouth, and chin to protect others. Please bring extra masks with you (WKC will not provide masks). While outside in the parking lot, a mask is not required provided you maintain a 6-foot distance from others.

**RING SETUP** – We will be conducting a one-ring Trial. Exhibitors will be asked to leave the premises at the conclusion of their final class. A warm up area inside will be provided only for the next handler and dog due in the ring due to space constraints.

**NO SPECTATORS** – No spectators will be permitted at these Trials. If an exhibitor requires an assistant, the assistant will be allowed access to the building after signing the COVID-19 waiver at the check-in table.

**NO CHILDREN** – No children under 18 years of age will be permitted at these Trials unless showing a dog.

**DOG EXERCISE AREA** – Dogs must be on a leash at all times, both inside and outside the building, except when being shown in the ring. Maintain at least the required six feet of distance while you are exercising/warming up your dog outside the building and in the potty area. Please pick up after your dog and dispose of dog waste in the receptacles located at the front entrance and the potty area.

**CHECK-IN PROCESS** - There will be a check-in table outside the main entrance (where the stairs are) of the building. In case of inclement weather, the check-in table will be inside the door where the stairs are. You are required to check-in prior to entering the building and may not check-in earlier than 60 minutes before the start of your class. During check-in you will receive your armband for your class (es), and receive instructions for navigating the building. Stay behind the tape line to maintain the six-foot distance from the check-in steward. **Masks must be worn during the check-in process.** If there is a line, maintain at least six feet between you and the next person.

**CRATING** – Indoor crating will be extremely limited. Only exhibitors who are showing two or more dogs will be allowed to crate in the building. Each person's crating area will have approximately six feet between the crate(s) and the next exhibitor. There will be no chairs available for the exhibitors. When you finish your class(es), and awards have been announced, you must leave the premises quickly. **YOU MUST BRING A CLEAN TARP/MAT TO PLACE UNDERNEATH YOUR CRATE AND CHAIR. ALL CRATES, CHAIRS, AND ANY PERSONAL BELONGINGS MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE BUILDING EACH DAY, EVEN IF YOU ARE COMPETING THE FOLLOWING DAY.**

**BUILDING ENTRANCE, EXIT, AND HAND HYGIENE** – Every time you enter the building, you are required to use the club-provided hand sanitizer. Please plan to bring your own hand sanitizer as well, in case the club runs low. Please follow directions from stewards on entering and leaving the building.

**CLASS STAGING** – The Judge or Steward will communicate where the exhibitor will stand and provide instructions on what to do with their leash. Be sure to remain at least six feet from the steward's table and the dog and handler leaving.

**CLASS AWARDS** – At the conclusion of each class, handlers and dogs will return to the ring entering six feet apart and going to a space six feet from anyone else. The judge will announce the placements/qualifiers. Handlers and dogs will leave the ring in reverse order. Rosettes and ribbons will be available for pickup in a designated area apart from the ring.

**FOOD** – There will be no food allowed in the building for exhibitors.

**PERIODIC CLEANING** – Door handles and common surfaces will be wiped down periodically throughout the Trial and at the end of each day.

**TRIAL CANCELLATION** – WKC reserves the right to cancel these Trials at any time.
